

<u>CONDITION 12D:</u> PRE-HARVEST TREATMENT AND INSPECTION OF POME FRUIT, PERSIMMON AND BLUEBERRY FRUIT – QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY – SYSTEMS APPROACH

Notes:

- For the purposes of excluding fruit flies from the Riverland Pest Free Area, produce treated and certified under this Condition is **strictly prohibited** from entry into the Riverland Pest Free Area.
- This Condition and associated assurance scheme, ICA21, is not accepted for the treatment and certification of stone fruit
- 1. To provide an adequate level of security against Queensland fruit fly pome fruit, persimmon, and blueberry fruit must receive a specific combination of pre-harvest treatment and post-harvest inspection utilising a systems approach.
- 2. The required treatments and inspections will be the conditions of an approved ICA Arrangement (ICA21).

Proof: Accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate or a Plant Health Assurance Certificate (ICA21).
